YOUR WINE LIST - 2023

WHITE

Bellefontaine Sauvignon Blanc, France / 28.00

Classic Sauvignon Blanc nose with herbaceous notes, yet with underlying ripeness. Very floral, wild flower aromas balanced with a lovely fresh and pure lemon zest. Very satisfying drop

Cape Heights Chenin Blanc, South Africa / 28.00

This wine displays classic baked apple and zippy citrus aromas with soft, delicate apple fruit on the palate balanced by crisp acidity

Chilford Hall , Rivey Hill, Cambridgeshire / 28.00

Pale straw in appearance, this wine has honeysuckle and blossom aromas. Sweet sherbet flavours lead to a finish of soft ripe pear and melon

Sierra Grande Sauvignon Blanc, Chile / 29.00

Perfumed nose with citrus, passion fruit and gooseberry. Crisp and tangy with really vibrant citrus and gooseberry, lots of fruit, with herbaceous notes in the background

Ancora Pinot Grigio, Italy / 30.00

This is a really delicious Pinot Grigio. Lovely fresh lemony nose, quite grapey with hints of ripe apple and some Grigio spice. Bright, crisp and fresh with lovely citrus and pear fruit, grapey too with good acidity. Really clean and tangy with good fruit weight

Mare Nostrum Picpoul de Pinet, France / 34.00

This is typically bright and fresh with apple, grape and melon aromas some lime citrus too. Really fresh, vibrant, clean and inviting. Full of grape, ripe apple, and citrus on the palate. Perfect aperitif and fish pairing

Apello Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand / 36.00

Perfumed nose with elderflower, grapefruit, hints of passion fruit and gooseberry. Crisp and aromatic with bags of citrus fruit, again grapefruit, elderflower, mango and a touch of gooseberry. Good acidity keeps it clean and its tangy and refreshing and a really good Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc. Nothing too overt and very drinkable

Domaine la Bastide Viognier, France / 38.00

Has quite a fresh nose with lemon and lime fruits, white flower notes and some herbaceous overtones. The palate is full and round with a refreshing amount of acidity and a good amount of citrus fruit and buttery peach flavour

Domaine Andre Dezat Sancerre, France / 47.00

Classic green citrus with herbaceous notes on the nose. Really crisp and clean with purity and minerality. Zesty lime citrus with hints of riper fruits, herbaceous and fresh, mouth-watering acidity and a lovely stony finish. Great example of high quality Sancerre with loads of character

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RED

Bellefontaine Malbec, France / 28.00

A well priced and tasty Malbec from southern France; bright red and black berry fruits on an attractive nose. Juicy berry and cherry fruits on a fresh yet quite soft palate, a hint of chocolate too. Very friendly style

Cape Heights Shiraz, South Africa / 28.00

Creamy brambly fruits on the nose with some spice and smoky notes. Juicy and bright plum and cherry fruits, fresh with spice and smoky notes. Has a classic South African flavour

Somborne Estate, Reserve Red, Hampshire / 28.00

Plum pudding, spice nose. Cherry palate, quite rich with a savoury note. This impressive wine has considerable depth and subtlety. Drinking chilled as a summer alternative to rosé is a revelation!

Sierra Grande Pinot Noir, Chile / 29.00

This is a really lovely, fresh Pinot Noir that is beautifully varietal; strawberry and cherry fruit on the appealing nose. Medium bodied, strawberry and cherry, just a hint of spice and soft tannins

Peculiar Mr. Pat Merlot, Australia / 30.00

Bright, plush, deeply tasty Merlot from Riverland vineyards, this is abundant in freshly picked red fruit, a hint of mint, with soft tannins and a long, moreish finish

Palacio del Camino Real Rioja Reserva, Spain / 36.00

A lovely full, quite opulent Rioja that is a real blend of traditional and modern stylistically. A blend of Tempranillo and Garnacha aged for 14 months in French and American oak, and then 18 months in bottle before release. Bright fruits with a typical meaty savoury character and some toasty oak. Spice and cedary notes too

Chateau Mayne-Viel Fronsac Bordeaux, France / 39.00

Packed with intense black mulberry flavoured fruit and firm but smooth tannins, the ripe fruit makes this very drinkable now

San Marzano 'Talo' Primitivo, Italy / 43.00

Rich and seductive with dark fruits, supple tannins and a lovely underlying ripeness/sweetness. Think almost a baby Port. Plush and intense, very moreish!

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ROSE

False Bay 'Whole Bunch' Cinsault Mourvèdre Rosé, South Africa / 28.00

Similar to a Provence Rose with just a touch deeper fruit, dry and fresh

Chateau St Pierre Rose de Provence, France / 36.00

Lovely pale pink coloured Provence rosé. Classic style with cherry and strawberry fruit, some spice to add interest, dry, fresh and very appealing. Stunning blush colour

Domaine Lafron-Veyrolles Badol Rosé, France / 47.00

Award winning Rose from the South of France. Touch fuller than most Provence styles, but still fresh and dry and very complex

FIZZ

Prosecco Lunetta, Italy / 41.50

A deliciously light and fruity Prosecco with hints of apple and peach on the nose and a fresh, softly sparkling palate. Cavit's Lunetta Prosecco is made exclusively from Prosecco grapes

Prosecco Lunetta Rose, Italy / 41.50

A fresh and dry sparkling rosé with persistent white foam, beautifully cherry pink in colour. Red berry characters on the nose and palate make this soft and approachable in character

Chateau de Moncontour Sparkling Vouvray Loire Brut, France / 50.00

Pale yellow with green hints. A fresh nose, with white flowers, brioche and apple aromas. Harmonious palate with a nice acidity and finesse. A fine example of sparkling Chenin Blanc

Champagne Gallimard Brut NV, France / 67.00

A Blanc de Noirs from Les Riceys, made with 100% Pinot Noir has been imported by our supplier for over 25 years! Well-aged and rounded with plenty of berry and citrus fruit, good acidity, and a long, biscuity complex finish. Simply stunning, forget the big names, this is the real deal!

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Chilford Hall , Rivey Hill, Cambridgeshire / 28.00

Pale straw in appearance, this wine has honeysuckle and blossom aromas. Sweet sherbet flavours lead to a finish of soft ripe pear and melon

New Hall Vineyard, Bacchus , Essex / 29.00

Aromas of elderflower, apple and conference pear. On the palate, tropical fruit flavours of melon and pineapple prevail leading to an elegant, crisp finish

Nutborne Vineyards, Bacchus , West Sussex / 32.00

An outstanding dry white wine that is crisp, fresh and enticing, made from 100% Bacchus grapes. A pronounced distinctive elderflower bouquet is followed by delicate gooseberries and a botanical aromatic finish

Litmus Wines, Pinot Noir, Surrey / 45.00

Pale golden in colour with hints of peach, smoke, and honeysuckle on the nose. The palate is structured with a fullness, complexity, and roundness not often found in English white wines. Rich and silky in texture

ENGLISH RED

Somborne Estate, Reserve Red, Hampshire / 28.00

Plum pudding, spice nose. Cherry palate, quite rich with a savoury note. This impressive wine has considerable depth and subtlety, making it an excellent accompaniment to a meal or simply for drinking with friends. Drinking chilled as a summer alternative to rosé is a revelation!

3 Choirs Vineyards, Ravens Hill, Gloucestershire / 32.00

A deep, ruby coloured red wine full of ripe blackberry and cherry fruit on the nose with a subtle hint of lightly toasted oak from the American oak Barrel ageing

Lyme Bay Winery , Pinot Noir, Devon / 45.00

Made from the best fruit available in the UK and aged in 30% new oak, this unique English Red wine displays a complex and intense array of black cherries, raspberries and bramble fruit, underpinned by subtle toasty oak

ENGLISH SPARKLING

Harrow and Hope, Brut Reserve, Buckinghamshire / 65.00

Soft and gentle character,. Always fresh and vibrant

Wiston Estate, Rose / 65.00

Bursts with aromatic notes of rhubarb, raspberry, strawberry, redcurrant as well as wild roses, lemon zest, and a touch of sherbet on the finish. It is a superbly elegant English

Langham Wine Estate, Culver Classic Cuvee, Dorset / 75.00

White peach and baked apple notes, this wine offers a round palate suited to all occasions. The Culver drinks equally well on its own
